

Jackson Creek Watershed Fuel Reduction Project Town Hall Meeting

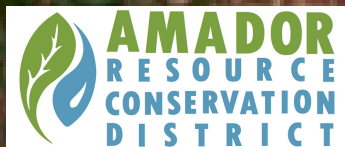
